SMALL IN SIZE BUT LOUD IN VOICE

Pk. Md. Motiur Rahman Honorary Professor, ISRT University of Dhaka

The Institute of Statistical Research and Training (ISRT) was started in July 1964 under the leadership of Professor Qazi Motahar Husain. ISRT is engaged in statistical teaching, research and other scholarly activities but it is small in terms of size or structure and other physical facilities. Despite the limitations of physical facilities, it has achieved academic excellence and quality education. Many graduates of ISRT are doing statistical work with great devotion in different Government and non-government organizations such as administrative services, Planning Commission, Bangladesh Bank, other schedule banks, Bangladesh Bureau of Statistics, insurance companies, ICDDR,B, public and private universities etc. Many teachers and students of ISRT are attending international conferences and many of them have received international awards for their scholarly research work and for being the best speaker in such conferences. Many graduates of ISRT have obtained Ph.D degrees from the leading universities of USA, Canada, U.K and Australia. Every year 3 to 4 ISRT graduates are going abroad for higher education. After receiving higher degrees leading to Ph.D, they are serving in ISRT and some are serving as faculty members in different universities of USA, Canada, U.K and Australia and they are the 'Loud Voice' of ISRT and flag bearer of the country.

BIRTH OF ISRTAA

Md. Hasinur Rahaman Khan Associate Professor, ISRT

With the view of setting up an alumni association of graduates in Applied Statistics from ISRT, an online group was first created in 2005 with the initiatives from ex-students of Applied Statistics. This group served as a common, virtual platform for the graduates till 2009. On 04 July 2009, an ad-hoc convening committee was formed in order to undertake the preliminary activities to establish the official alumni association in ISRT. The convening committee was formed with Prof. Dr. M Sekander Hayat Khan as Chair and many ex-students of Applied Statistics as members. On July 14, 2009 Karar Zunaid Ahsan, on behalf of the committee, sent the first draft of

the constitution to alumni google-group for feedback. Many comments and suggestions on the constitution and its name were received. The name was proposed as "Applied Statistics Alumni Association (ASAA)" and this was agreed to by almost all members of the group. It was decided that Dr. Israt Rayhan's office in ISRT would be used as the Alumni Relations Office on a temporary basis. In mid 2010, Dr. Enayetur Raheem created alumni Facebook group and proposed a website and domain as www.alumni.isrt.ac.bd. By the end of 2010 the draft of the constitution got significant improvement through the feedback of senior faculty members of ISRT and some ex-students of Applied Statistics. A membership form and receipt were designed and membership fee was fixed as BDT 2000.

Despite the significant progress on the formation of the alumni during 2009-2012, on 18 May 2013, an ad-hoc committee was formed to boost up all activities including forming effective batch representatives, finalizing the alumni constitution, registering the alumni association and officially forming the association. The ad-hoc committee was comprised of the following persons: Dr. Hasinur Rahaman Khan (Chair), Dr. Enayetur Raheem and Kamrul Hasan Kochi (Co-Chairs), Karar Zunaid Ashen (Secretary), Ashraful Islam Khokon (Communication Secretary), and Nabil Awan (Joint Secretary). A three-member sub-committee (Karar Zunaid Ahsan, Nabil Awan, Ashraful Islam Khokon) was also formed to fine tune the constitution

Alumni Association (ASAA)". The progress under the ad-hoc committee got a new dimension. Since May 2013, the committee had been continuously arranging batch representative meetings, annual alumni iftar event, motivating the graduates, finalizing membership form and receipt, and collecting alumni life members that grew to 36 till June 2017.

On 10 June 2017, the ad-hoc committee

along with the present ISRT Director Prof. Dr. Israt Rayhan organized an alumni iftar event where it was decided that on 18 July 2017, the existing ad-hoc committee would be revised to expedite the process of finalizing the ISRTAA constitution and forming the alumni association. The ad-hoc committee Chair Dr. Hasinur Rahaman Khan and ISRT Director were instrumental to change the name of the association to ISRT Alumni Association (ISRTAA) from the Applied Statistics Alumni Association (ASAA). Both motivated all the Applied Statistics graduates who were present in the iftar event. Later, on 18 July 2017, the ad-hoc committee was revised. The committee was comprised of the following persons: Dr. Hasinur Rahaman Khan (Convener), Ashraful Islam Khokon (Joint Convener-1), Shofigul Islam (Joint Convener-2) and 18 members. Also, a new eight-member sub-committee led by Dr. Hasinur Rahaman Khan was also formed on the same day to revise and finalize the initial draft of the constitution of the alumni association under alumni's proposed name "Institute of Statistical Research and



and the committee finalized the draft for the alumni association which was given the initial name "Applied Statistics Members of first BOT and EC on stage
Training Alumni Association (ISRTAA)".
The sub-committee finalized the constitution over dozen meetings in quick

time. It was decided on the batch representative meeting held on 11 November 2017 that 11 new batch representatives of M. Stat and M. Demography would be added to the existing ad-hoc committee to organize the first ever reunion of ISRTAA and to announce formally the formation of the ISRTAA. By the first week of January 2018, the number of life members went up to 238.

ISRT and the new ad-hoc committee jointly decided to organize the first ever reunion of ISRTAA on January 27, 2018. On January 27, 2018 a general meeting and reunion of the ISRT graduates under ISRTAA banner was organized in which Prof. Dr. M. Sekander Hayat Khan presided over the meeting and the Honorable Vice Chancellor, University of Dhaka formally announced the formation of ISRTAA as Chief Guest. The ISRT Director Prof. Dr. Israt Rayhan and the above ad-hoc committee played the key role to organize such an event. After discussions with the alumni members and with full consensus, two formal committees were formed: the Board of Trustees (BOT) and the Executive Committee (EC). Members of these two committees shall be treated as founding members. The BOT comprised of 9 members-- Professor Dr. M. Sekander Hayat Khan (Chair), Professor Dr. Pk. Md. Motiur Rahman (Vice Chair), Dr. Md. Hasinur Rahaman Khan (Member Secretary as EC President), Professor Dr. Israt Rayhan (member as Director of ISRT), Professor Dr. Syed Shahadat Hossain (member as nominee of ISRT Academic Committee), Professor Dr. Amir Hossain (member as nominee of ISRT Academic Committee), Mr. Abu Yusuf Chowdhury (member), Mr. Jamal Mohammed Abu Naser (member), Dr. Mohammad Sohrab Uddin (member). The EC comprised of Dr. Md. Hasinur Rahaman Khan (President), Mr. Igbal Ahammed (Vice President-I), Mr. Md. Mustafa Kamal (Vice President-II), Md. Ashraful Islam Khokon (Secretary), Mr. Md. Masud Reza (Joint Secretary-I), Mr. Sajal Kanti Howlader (Joint Secretary-II), Dr. Iftakhar Alam (Treasurer), Mr. Md. Azad Uddin (Cultural Affairs Secretary), Mr. Anaet Shawon (Communication Secretary). The members are Professor Rejuan Hossain Bhuiyan, Mr. Mohammad Ahsanul Alam, Mr. Md. Shaheen Howlader, Professor Dr. Tamanna Howlader, Mr. Mohammed Tofazzal Hossain, Mr. Md. Mahbubul Haque, Mr. Md. Shofiqul Islam, Mr. Md. MY EXPECTATIONS FROM ISRTAA

I congratulate the faculties, students, staff and the alumni association of ISRT on launching of the ISRTAA Newsletter. I would like to take this opportunity to briefly share my expectations from the alumni association and, more importantly, what ISRTAA can do about it.

From networking to career advisory to mentoring—there are many reasons for establishing an alumni association for an academic institute. Encouraged by the successful launching of ISRTAA in January 2018, I put forward the following for kind consideration of the EC and the BOT of our newly-formed alumni association:

Spread the word (with attention to details)

ISRTAA provides a unique opportunity to boost our academic program's profile and highlight new courses/initiatives. It also acts as the platform for networking between the past and present graduates. While the homepage of ISRT's official website is up to date, pages for people (www.isrt.ac.bd/people) and alumni (www.isrt.ac.bd/category/alumni) require regular updates and redesigning. For example, only a working email address may be sufficient as the mode of contact and "View profile" button can only be available for the persons who have a profile created.

Share the vision

The constitution of ISRTAA articulates the vision, mission and goals of the alumni association. I believe it would be useful for all of us to learn how the alumni association plans to materialize its objectives. ISRTAA Newsletter can regularly publish short interviews of one or two EC/BOT members in each issue where they will have the opportunity to share their vision with the alumni.

Engage new graduates

For an institution that started in 1964, it is expected that the alumni committee will be inclusive and have a focus on 'rekindling old flames' by engaging graduates of the earlier decades. In order to build a 21st century alumni engagement organization, ISRTAA may want to focus on turning the recent graduates into active alumni— a graduate who is working in a professional field for some years would be a remarkable mentor for the current students or fresh graduates because of the common saying: there isn't any better short-term career advice you can get than from someone who is in the job you're looking for. ISRTAA may actively encourage young graduates to take part in the alumni committee or even tailor specific alumni activities to their needs to increase their participation.
